Objectives

To encourage voluntary blood donation among students and community members.

To raise awareness about the importance of blood donation.

To support local blood banks and hospitals.

Preparation

The camp was organized in collaboration with Rampurhat Medical College & Hospital. Extensive preparations included: Posters and announcements were made to inform students and the community about the event, Registration Process: A pre-registration system was established to manage donor flow efficiently, Medical Arrangements: A team of qualified medical personnel was coordinated to oversee the donation process and ensure donor safety.

Execution

On the day of the camp, the following activities took place:

Registration: Donors were registered and briefed about the donation process.

Health Screening: Medical staff conducted health screenings to ensure donor eligibility.

Blood Donation: Donors participated in the donation process, which was conducted in a safe and hygienic environment.

Post-Donation Care: Refreshments were provided to donors post-donation to aid recovery.

Results

Total Donations:41 units of blood were collected.

Participant Feedback: Many participants expressed satisfaction with the organization and indicated a willingness to donate again in the future.

The camp significantly contributed to the local blood supply and raised awareness about the critical need for blood donations. It also fostered a sense of community and encouraged young individuals (students) to engage in social responsibility.

Conclusion




