**Participants' Details:** We took 26 students of fourth standard of Atgram Primary School and a total number of 03 Faculty members and 06 students of Semester III & V of the Department of English, Hiralal Bhakat College, Nalhati, Birbhum.

**Objectives:** The objective of the programme was to –

- 1. Promote Englishs readership among Atgram Primary School.
- 2. Enhance literacy skills among the students.
- 3. Foster a reading culture and love for reading.
- 4. Improve their language skills.

#### **Details:**

#### Introduction:

The Department of English and the IQAC Coordinator of Hiralal Bhakat College, Nalhati, Birbhum, WB, India, collaborated on a two-week outreach program from 15/11/21 to 30/11/21aimed at promoting English readership and distributing English storybooks at Atgram Primary School. The initiative was a great success and was designed to enhance literacy skills among the students and foster a love for reading. The outreach programme spanned 15 days and

involved various activities focused on promoting English readership and providing students with access to quality story books. The programme was designed to engage students in interactive learning experiences and foster a love for reading and language development.

#### **Activities:**

**Day 1-7:** Book Distribution and Storytelling Sessions: English storybooks were distributed to the students of Atgram Primary School, ranging from fairy tales to educational books, to cater to different interests and reading levels. On the final day, a culmination event was held to celebrate the success of the programme and gather feedback from students, teachers, and volunteers. Students shared their experiences, favourite stories, and expressed gratitude for the opportunity to engage with in this programme in a fun and interactive way.
