A- Context:

The Department of Arabic at HiralalBhakat College, Nalhati, Birbhum, has initiated a sixmonth Certificate Course titled "Certificate in Spoken Arabic (CSA)" with the objective of enhancing participants' speaking proficiency in Functional Arabic. The course aimed to equip students with the necessary skills to communicate effectively in Arabic. Hence, the course curriculum has been designed to focus on practical spoken Arabic, enabling students to engage confidently in everyday conversations.

B- Objective of the Course:

After completing the course, a student will be able to:

- Have a simple conversation in spoken Arabic.
- Understand and use familiar expressions used in daily life.
- Interact with Arabic Speaking people using clear and simple sentences.
- Describe things, places and personalities.
- Finally, the student will be able to work in different sectors on various positions.

And a student will be able to work for the following sectors/positions:

- Work for MNCs/BPOs/KPOs.
- Work in tourism sector and Medical Tourism.
- Work in Arab Countries.
- Work as Translators and interpreters (Basic level).

C- Methodology:

To enhance communicative proficiency in Arabic, the teacher will implement a range of innovative methodologies. These include:

- **Communicative Language Teaching (CLT):** This approach focuses on interactive communication as the primary means of language acquisition, emphasizing real-life conversation and functional language use.
- Task-Based Language Teaching (TBLT): This method involves the use of structured tasks or activities that simulate real-world scenarios, encouraging students to use Arabic in practical contexts to achieve specific outcomes.
- Interactive Techniques: These techniques promote active student engagement through activities such as role-playing, group discussions, and collaborative exercises, designed to facilitate dynamic language practice.
- Listening and Pronunciation Practice: Dedicated sessions will be included to enhance listening skills and improve pronunciation, ensuring students can accurately comprehend and produce the Arabic language.

D- Eligibility Criteria:

- Age Requirement: Minimum Age: 18 years Maximum Age: No upper limit
- Educational Qualification: Must have completed 10+2 (High School or equivalent)
- Language Proficiency: Candidate should know how to read and write Arabic

E- Course Outcome:

Upon successful completion of the **Certificate in Spoken Arabic (CSA)** course at HiralalBhakat College, Nalhati, Birbhum, students will achieve the following outcomes:

- 1. **Proficiency in Conversational Arabic**: Students will be able to engage in simple conversations in spoken Arabic, using clear and straightforward sentences to interact effectively in everyday situations.
- 2. Understanding Common Expressions: Students will demonstrate the ability to understand and use familiar expressions and phrases pertinent to daily life, including greetings, expressions of gratitude, and common situational phrases.
- 3. Effective Interaction with Arabic Speakers: Students will possess the skills necessary to interact confidently with Arabic-speaking individuals, enabling them to describe people, places, and objects with appropriate vocabulary and sentence structures.
- 4. **Practical Application in Various Sectors**: Students will be prepared to apply their language skills in various sectors. They will be eligible for roles in:
 - Multinational Corporations (MNCs), Business Process Outsourcing (BPO) and Knowledge Process Outsourcing (KPO) firms.
 - The tourism and medical tourism sectors.
 - Arab countries, potentially for employment or further education.
 - Basic-level translation and interpretation services.
- 5. **Preparation for Professional Opportunities**: Through special lectures and insights into job scopes and opportunities in Arabic-speaking regions and sectors, students will be equipped to pursue relevant career paths and applications of their language skills.

Hence, the **CSA** course will enable participants to transition from basic understanding to practical application, enhancing their employment prospects and communication abilities in Arabic-speaking environments.
