The programme started at 10.30 AM with inaugural song by students of history department. Opening remarks and introduction of the seminar were given Dr. Suddhasattwa Banerjee, coordinator of IQAC of the college. It was followed by presentation of bouquet of flowers and traditional shawl to the dignitaries on the dais by the students.

The seminar had an auspicious start with welcome address by Honourable Teacher In Charge, Prof Goutam Sen. In his address, he spoke about how our perceptions of history are coloured by textbooks or by narratives that favour a

specific view. This can create gaps, distortions, and sometimes even bitterness. It can leave us divided when, instead, history should unite us. He stressed that by educating students about the full spectrum of Indian history, we foster critical thinking, empathy, and a sense of national pride built on a firm foundation. He ended his address by saying that we learn from the mistakes of the past to chart a brighter future.

The keynote address of the seminar was delivered by eminent historian Dr. Syed Tanveer Nasreen. In her thought provoking lecture she shed light on the need of rewriting history from the vast sections of unrepresented groups like farmers, artisans, women, indigenous people and minority groups. Their

struggles, triumphs, and perspectives are missing from the grand narrative. By including these diverse voices, we rewrite history not just factually, butemotionally. She also talked about the sacrifices of those who built our society from the ground up and the need of a new historical gaze to rewrite history.

The next speaker of the seminar was eminent historian Dr. Aparajita Dhar, Associate Professor Department of History, University of Burdwan. In her speech she focused the spotlight on women's health in colonial India – a topic often shrouded in silence. The colonial era, with its drastic social and political changes, significantly impacted the well-being of women. Restricted mobility,

limited access to education, and prevailing social norms regarding female modesty all contributed to a lack of awareness about health and hygiene. Colonial healthcare systems, largely focused on urban areas and catered to the British and upper classes , most often neglecting the specific needs of lower classes. She also talked about factors like child marriage, poor nutrition, and inadequate medical care during pregnancy and childbirth in colonial India , and how this resulted in alarmingly high maternal mortality rates. In the last part of her speech she talked about glimmers of hope in this dark landscape, in the form of courageous women, like Dr. Kadambini Ganguly and Anandibai Gopalrao


Joshi who broke several barriers to receive medical education. She also talked about role of Missionary hospitals in colonial India.
