Un-Partitioned Bengal was regarded by the colonial Imperial Master as the Crown Jewel of the British Empire whose Sun has never been set down. Bengal had presented a large number of luminaries in the different spheres of life from intellectual to entrepreneurship. In the present canvas, we have selected one of the most outstanding personalities of the time. He is none the less, Sher-E-Bangla Abul kasem Fazlul Haq. Whose thoughts and actions had played crucial role in shaping political atlas of the Indian subcontinent nay Bengal. He was the first Prime Minister of Un-Partitioned Bengal (1st April' 1937 - 29th March' 1943) and was also the Mayor of Calcutta Corporation (30th April' 1935 - 29th April' 1936). Among his well-wishers there were Prafulla Chandra Roy and Asutosh Mukhopadhyay. He was one of the patrons of the magazine, named 'Nabayug' edited by Kazi Nazrul Islam and Muzaffar Ahmad. He being a renowned lawyer of that period ventured into several reform movements in academic, cultural and social realms of that period. He supported Bengali Language Movement in 1952 and never hesitated to forsake his political career from his post in any of the prominent parties as varied as Indian National Congress and Muslim League while protesting against any of the attempts to lower the status of Bengali Nationalism. To commemorate the sesquicentennial birth anniversary of Sher-E-Bangla in befitting manner, we are going to organise an International Seminar on 5th and 6th January of 2024 in the college premises. Both veteran and budding scholars of the professional academic world will participate in the proposed mega Seminar. A versatile and stormy- petrel of the Indian Political sky's different facades of life will be unfolded.
