Other Information Regarding Eligibility Criteria

- (a) Admission will be made strictly as per guideline and vacant intake capacity.
- (b) For candidates who passed HS (10+2) level or equivalent examination in **2022/2023/2024/2025** are eligible for application in first semester UG courses for the session 2025-26.
- (c) For candidates who passed in HS(10+2)level or equivalent examination in **vocational Business & Commerce**, can apply for admission in 4-years B.Com(Hons.) in Accountancy/Finance (major) or 3-years B.A./B.Sc. Programme.
- (d) For candidates who passed in HS (10+2)level or equivalent examination in **vocational engineering & technology (with pass marks in Mathematics)**, can apply for admission in 3-years B.A./B.Sc. Programme.

(e) For candidates who passed in HS(10+2)level or equivalent examination in **vocational agriculture**, can apply for admission in 3-years B.A./B.Sc. Programme.

(f) For candidates who passed in HS(10+2)level or equivalent examination in **vocational home science**, can apply for admission in 3-years B.A. Programme.

(g) For candidates who passed in vocational courses can take admission in first semester at most 10% seats of total intake of the relevant subject. It is to be noted that the merit mark of a candidate passing in vocational courses will be greater than the merit mark of last candidate passing from general board.

(h) Each candidate should read thoroughly the subject combinations available in the website.

(i) Reservation policies (SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, PH, Sports, EWS) of the Government will be followed.

(j) For sports quota, candidate can apply for 3-years UG Programme with International/National/State/ district level sports certificate.

(k) The **MAJOR subject** of 4-years UG programme will be treated as **HONOURS subject**.

(l) The degree of 3-years UG programme will be provided according to **MAJOR subject**.

(m) Filling up of form online does not mean guarantee of admission.

Procedure

At the time of online admission for Semester-I for the session 2025-2026, candidates must follow the following steps and precedures.

Step-1: At first, generate a valid **Email Id** of the candidate and keep a **WhatsApp mobile number**. Remember that one email ID and one mobile number can be used for one candidate's application only. It cannot be used for another candidate.

Step-2: First fill up the candidate's name and general information in the link given in the website www.hbcnht.edu.in.

Step-3: After registration, fill up the other necessary information and upload the scanned copies of the candidate's photo and signature.

Step-5: After uploading documents, read the declaration carefully and approve it by clicking the indicated box and submit the application finally.

Step: 6: Take a printout of online application form for verification in future.
